## Biography

Sarah Theodosia Branson was born in 1793. She married Henry Edward Hall jnr.<sup>1</sup>

and they emigrated to Western Australia in 1830 with six children:<sup>2</sup> Sarah Louisa (aged 10), Henry Hastings (8), Laetitia (7), Theodosia Sophia (2), William Shakespeare Hall<sup>3</sup> (4) and James Anderton Hall<sup>4</sup> (1). Two of William and James' grandchildren, Helen Margaret Hall<sup>5</sup> and William Murray Wilson<sup>6</sup>, were married in 1949. Sarah died on 17 February 1858.<sup>2</sup>

1 DESCRIPTION: Death certificate of Sarah Theodosia Hall, who died on 17 February 1858, in the Canning district, aged 63. She was the wife of Henry Edward Hall (yeoman). Cause of death: inflammation of the lungs.

Informant: J.A. Hall<sup>7</sup>, son. Reported: 18 February 1858. Registrar: J.M. Giffin.
