This Agreement, made the 9th day of July

alias Whulstone

an aboriginal native, witnesseth

1. The said Whulstone agrees
to serve W. J. Hall

2 Here state the capacity in which the aboriginal is to serve

as: general servant

2. Such service to last until July 9th 1895

3. Whulstone is to begin
work on the 9th day of July 1894

4. W. J. Hall is to supply
Whulstone during the said
service with medicines and medical attendance when practicable and
necessary, unless the illness of Whulstone
be caused by his own improper act or default.
